FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

PAYMENT/LATE FEES/CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

A \$40 non-refundable deposit is due at the time of Full Day Camp registration, for each week of camp you are registering for. The remaining balance must be paid in full the Wednesday prior to camp start date. Payments may be scheduled for Automatic Deduction upon request. Please stop by the Welcome Center to make arrangements for your Automatic Deduction. Registrations or payments made after the Wednesday prior to the start of the camp week will be charged a \$40 late fee.

CAMP SAFETY AND STAFF TRAINING
